


# HANDLEBAR ROLLOP

## Mounting instructions

*Please note: Attaching bags to your bike may cause damage to its paintwork. To protect against wear and tear, we recommend applying protective tape over attachment points on your bike's frame before using any bags.*




1. Unclip the buckles at the bottom of bag.
2. Slide product down over your Fjällräven Handlebar Rack ensuring the webbing straps (**A**) are to the rear of the frame. Also ensure that the webbing straps at the base of the bag (**B**) are hanging behind the rear horizontal tube (**C**) and the webbing

- straps (**D**) are in front of the front horizontal tube (**E**).
3. Secure the bag to Fjällräven Handlebar Rack with the side release buckles (**F**) and tighten the webbing straps firmly with velcro.
4. Close the rolltop of the bag at the sides (recommended in heavy rain) or at the top.

Mounting instructions



**WARNING!** Only mount, open or access bags when the bike is stationary. Doing so while riding can lead to loss of control and serious injury. Before riding, ensure that all bags are correctly mounted, and items in the bags are properly stored. Loose bags or items falling out can cause loss of control and result in serious injury. Adding weight to your bike may affect handling. Practice riding with a loaded bag in a controlled environment away from traffic before setting out on your biking adventure.
