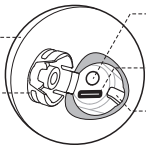

HOW TO USE

Power on and select an interactive mode.

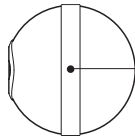


ON / OFF

*Long Press for
3 Seconds

Switch Modes

*Short Press Once



Blue: Hybrid Mode
(Vibrate or Fast Roll)

Green: Bounce Mode
(Tap to Bounce)

Purple: Roll Mode
(Shake or Slow Roll)

HOW TO USE

Two ways to activate Wicked Ball M3:



(1) Tap or shake it, and the Wicked Ball M3 will activate immediately.



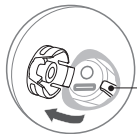
(2) Wait for 5 seconds, and the Wicked Ball M3 will activate automatically.



Wicked Ball M3 will enter a 30-minute sleep period after 10 minutes of play-time. This is to avoid exhaustion and ensure moderate exercise for your pet. If the Wicked Ball M3 is touched again while it's sleeping, it will end the rest early and continue to play with your pet.

HOW TO INSTALL THE BELL (OPTIONAL)

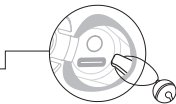
1. Open the silicone cap.



3. Securely tighten string to ensure the bell hangs securely.



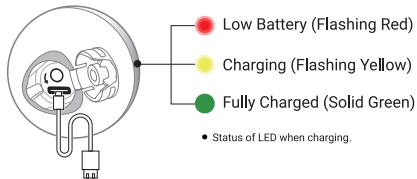
2. Thread one end of the bell cord through the hook.



4. Close the silicone cap to prevent the bell from accidentally falling off.



HOW TO CHARGE



Before charging, please clean the foreign matter of the charging port and keep the charging port dry.

When the Wicked Ball M3 shows any of the following conditions, it indicates low battery and needs to be charged:

1. The indicator light flashes red after powering on, then automatically shuts down.
2. No respond to long press of the function button.

PROMPT TONE INSTRUCTIONS



Status	Meaning	How to Unlock
A short 'beep' sound indicates the current interactive mode, with the indicator light displaying the corresponding color.	Switch Mode.	Activate Wicked Ball M3.
Regular 'beep—' sound with a long prompt tone, and the indicator light flashes red.	Low battery level.	Connect to power source or power off.
Regular 'beep—' sound with a long prompt tone, and the indicator light does not emit light.	Stuck for more than 10 minutes.	Touch to activate or power off.
